years ago. This book offers us several themes, such as kindness, friendship, family, and a love of learning. Evan and his best friend Rafe quickly discover a link between one of the old books and a long-ago event that none of the grown-ups want to talk about. The two boys start asking questions whose answers will transform not only their own futures, but the town itself.

There are links below to order your book so you are ready for the book club to begin, on Friday, April 19 **Next**, Friday, April 19 families will receive their first reading assignment and discussion questions, these will be posted to a private Facebook page (please join, search Facebook for **WPES**, **One Book One Community**), posted on my <u>website</u>, and sent through email. **Then**, families read assigned pages and discuss the story, with the guiding questions. The next day at school your child will have the opportunity during morning announcements to answer a trivia question about the previous night's reading. **Finally**, you can then expect discussion questions to be posted every other day.
