- The Rockton Grade School Project Fair is scheduled for **Thursday April 4, 2019**
- Entry forms are due by Friday **March 15, 2019**
- The objective of this activity is to give students an opportunity to further their understanding and knowledge in a particular area of interest. It helps students learn how to choose a topic, do some research, write a report and carry out a project to completion. Family participation is encouraged. Having a good learning experience is more important than the student doing every step themselves. However, at completion, each student will be expected to have a good understanding and knowledge of the project.
- We encourage students to participate however, participation is not required.
- The Fair will accept projects in art, language arts, math, science and social studies.
- Each participant will receive a medal. The judges may recognize a few projects as outstanding. These projects will receive a ribbon.
- Parents are invited to view and pick up projects the evening of April 4th from 6:00-7:00 p.m

PRESENTATION AND DISPLAY

1. All projects, except art and language arts, must use a rigid material (stiff cardboard, pressed wood, etc.) that stands alone to make a background for display of data and to frame the project. All projects will be displayed on tables with 3 feet allowed per project. Due to table availability and fairness to all, please conform to these specifications.

2. All projects must have some written explanation including the purpose of the project. This can be in report form or as part of the project presentation. Additional information such as a progress log, math data and/or bibliography should be included where appropriate.

3. Bring your project to the RGS cafeteria on Wednesday April 3, 2019 after school until 3:30 or from 6:00-7:00 pm. At that time you will "check in" and set up your project.

EVALUATION

Each student who submits a project will talk about their project with a judge who will ask the following questions:

1. Tell me about your project?
2. What is your favorite thing about your project?
3. What was the hardest part to do?
4. Did you learn anything new while doing your project?
5. How would you rate your project?
